

Course Description

CTE2745C | Patternmaking Level 2 | 3.00 credits

This course focuses the integration of flat pattern and draping. The student will learn the foundations of draping as a design development and execution technique. How to move from the form to the flat and on to the body. Prerequisite: CTE1743C, CTE2310C.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will develop corset and draped designs by:

- 1. Developing sketches conveying design concepts
- 2. Creating style lines on the dress form
- 3. Draping, marking, and truing pattern pieces
- 4. Producing a fully finished sewn design

Competency 2: The student will combine bodice blocks and draping techniques to develop new designs by:

- 1. Combining dart and style line manipulation with draping
- 2. Utilizing advanced pattern elements to develop new patterns and designs
- 3. Demonstrating the ability to incorporate various sleeve styles into the bodice/torso designs

Competency 3: The student will assess fit consistent with design intent by:

- 1. Incorporating fit techniques appropriate to the chosen final fabrics
- 2. Applying the design elements to ensure the aesthetic of the design appropriate to the target client
- 3. Identifying types of fabric necessary for design element

- Formulate strategies to locate, evaluate, and apply information
- Demonstrate an appreciation for aesthetics and creative activities
