

Course Description

DEH1710 | Oral Health Literacy | 1.00 credit

Students will learn the concepts of oral health literacy. Students will also identify how to improve a patient's oral health literacy and the barriers that impede oral health care.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate knowledge and comprehension of oral health literacy by:

- 1. Defining oral health literacy
- 2. Discussing the basic concepts of health literacy and its relation to oral health
- 3. Summarizing the impact of oral health literacy on an individual's health
- 4. Implementing strategies to improve oral health literacy with patients

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate knowledge and comprehension of oral health care by:

- 1. Identifying communication and other barriers that impede effective oral health communication
- 2. Describing and utilizing techniques to improve oral health communication and increase understanding by individuals with limited health literacy
- 3. Collaborating with community partners on oral health literacy issues

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate knowledge and comprehension of the impact culture has on oral health care by:

- 1. Defining cultural competence
- 2. Identifying the impact culture has on health behaviors and attitudes
- 3. Implementing strategies to overcome cultural barriers to oral health care

- Solve problems using critical and creative thinking and scientific reasoning
- Formulate strategies to locate, evaluate, and apply information
