#### **EPI0020 | Professional Foundations | 1.00 credit**

The student will learn to evaluate his/ her role as a productive member of the teaching profession. The student will learn to reflect on his/her development and mastery of the Pre-Professional Florida Educator Accomplished Practices during the completion of the Clinical Education experience in a P-12 classroom setting. Pre-requisites: EPI0002.

### **Course Competencies**

2. Identifying instruction that uses a variety of culturally and linguistically relevant materials and resources in P- 12 settings
