

Course Description

FIL1431C | Film Production 2: Cinematography and Sound | 4.00 credits

An introductory course where students will learn cinematography and sync-sound motion picture production. Prerequisite: FIL1420C; Corequisite: FIL2553C

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency in the use of the basic lighting and sound tools by:

- 1. Identifying the components of lighting and sound equipment
- 2. Operating lighting and sound equipment
- 3. Incorporating artificial lighting and sound in a motion picture production

Competency 2: The student will be able to modify the lighting and sound of a scene according to its dramatic content by:

- 1. Defining lighting and sound elements
- 2. Designing lighting schemes and sound plans for various moods and situations
- 3. Analyzing and understanding the visual, sound, and thematic contents of a scene
- 4. Determining the emotional effects of different lighting and sound setups

Competency 3: The student will be able to integrate dramatic cinematography and sound by:

- 1. Using depth of field and focusing techniques
- 2. Distinguishing microphone placement
- 3. Analyzing the visual and dramatic effects of camera movement
- 4. Combining camera movement, lighting, and sound
