

Course Description

FIL2560C | Editing Level 3: Advanced Editing: Color Correction and Finishing | 3.00 credits

An advanced course in which students will learn the practice of color correcting and finishing fiction and non-fiction projects. Prerequisite: FIL2553C.

Course Competencies:

- 1. Arranging industry workflows from acquisition to delivery
- 2. Identifying various monitoring and display tools for effective quality control
- 3. Implementing standard codes and formats

- 1. Identifying industry standard distribution methods
- 2. Demonstrating online video uploading techniques

- 1. Identifying the various applications for manipulated images
- 2. Developing a vocabulary for image manipulation techniques
- 3. Enhancing images using image manipulation software
- 4. Applying enhanced images to a media project
