



### **Course Description**

#### **IND1300 | Interior Design Presentations 1 | 2.00 credits**

An introductory course in the use of various media for presentation of plans, schemes, and interior perspective renderings. Prerequisite: IND1020; Corequisite: IND1200.

### **Course Competencies**

1. Investigating different types of presentation tools and techniques.
2. Experimenting with traditional and digital formats for visual representation.
3. Analyzing the advantages and limitations of each media type.

2. Assessing the clarity and effectiveness of visual elements in conveying design intent.
3. Comparing the impact of various media on audience engagement and understanding.

1. Utilizing software tools for creating digital renderings and presentations.
2. Implementing best practices in layout and composition for effective visual communication.
3. Integrating feedback to refine and improve presentation techniques continuously.
