



Course Description

MSL2101 | Second Year Basic Army ROTC | 2.00 credits

Instruction in squad and platoon marching drills, military training and inspections, leadership techniques, advanced map reading, and refresher in skills learned at earlier levels. Physical fitness training and lab required.

Competency 1: ROTC MS II Course and Purpose:

MSL2101 Fall semester focuses on Army Doctrine and Decision Making. The course begins with analytical techniques, creative thinking skills and the Army problem solving process as related to situations faced by leaders when making decisions.

Troop leading procedures (TLP's) and an operations order (OPORD) will lead Cadets to an understanding of Army Doctrine and Symbology. Cadets are then required to apply their knowledge outside the classroom in a hands-on performance-oriented environment during a weekly lab facilitated by MSLIII Cadets and supervised by cadre.
