

Course Description

MUM1930 | Introduction to DJing | 3.00 credits

This is a course designed to continue training in a student's field of study through work experience. The student will gain practical experience in international affairs by working in a consulate, governmental agency, non-governmental organization, private voluntary organization, or institute. Prerequisite: Department Approval.

Competency 1: Students will demonstrate the fundamental concepts of DJing by:

- 1. Explaining the role of a DJ in the music industry and its evolution over time
- 2. Identifying and differentiating between various DJ equipment and their functions
- 3. Demonstrating an understanding of the basic terminology and vocabulary used in DJing

Competency 2: Students will develop technical skills in DJing by:

- 1. Operating DJ equipment effectively and efficiently, including turntables, CDJs, and controllers
- 2. Utilizing DJ software to mix and blend tracks seamlessly
- 3. Beatmatching techniques are applied to synchronize the tempo and rhythm of different songs

Competency 3: Students will apply creative techniques in DJ performances by:

- 1. Utilizing effects, loops, and samples to enhance mixes and create unique sounds
- 2. Incorporating scratching and other turntablism techniques to add flair and creativity to performances
- 3. Experimenting with different mixing styles and transitions to develop a personal DJing style

Competency 4: Students will develop performance and crowd engagement skills by:

- 1. Reading and responding to the energy of a live audience to create an engaging atmosphere
- 2. Selecting and sequencing tracks effectively to maintain the flow and energy of a DJ set
- 3. Utilizing microphones and communication techniques to interact with the audience during performances

Competency 5: Students will develop an understanding the business and professional aspect of DJing by:

- 1. Exploring career opportunities and paths within the DJ industry
- 2. Demonstrating the importance of professionalism, ethics, and legal considerations in DJing
- 3. Developing effective networking and promotional strategies to establish and advance a DJ career
