

## **Course Description**

## MUT2116 | Theory 3 | 3.00 credits

The continuation of modulation and the presentation of diatonic sevenths, secondary dominants, altered chords, augmented and Neapolitan sixths; melodic and harmonic analysis of selected works; ninth, eleventh, and thirteenth chords, and instrumental part writing. Prerequisite: MUT 1112; Corequisite: MUT 2246.
