



Course Description

MUT2239 | Jazz Keyboard Harmony 2 | 1.00 credit

Experience with extended and altered harmonic progression. Will include harmonic analysis and bitonal structures.

Prerequisite: MUT2238; corequisite: MUT2352.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate technical proficiency in functional jazz harmony by:

1. Understanding and performing harmonic progressions with secondary dominant chords
2. Understanding and performing the modes of the major and melodic minor scales

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate the utilization of chord types by:

1. Understanding and performing 9th chords in root position and inversions
2. Understanding and performing altered dominant 7th chords

Competency 3: The student will be able to apply techniques of harmonic analysis and basic compositional techniques by:

1. Composing various song types and song forms
2. Performing harmonic analysis on advanced jazz compositions

Competency 4: The student will demonstrate knowledge and proficiency in jazz piano skills by:

1. Performing advanced jazz standards
2. Demonstrating skills in improvisation commensurate with the harmonic content presented in class
