

## **Course Description**

## MUT2351 | Introduction to Popular Music Arranging | 3.00 credits

Provides basic experience with instrumental, ranges, transpositions, two-and three-part writing. Prerequisite: MUT1112 or permission of instructor; corequisite: MUT2238.

## **Course Competencies:**

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate technical proficiency in music, handwriting, and notation by:

1. Writing all musical elements (notes, articulation, chord symbols, etc.) in grand staff

**Competency 2:** The student will demonstrate an understanding of the harmonic and rhythmic structures of music by:

- 1. Writing and transposition of basic harmonic structures in all 12 keys for various instrumentation
- 2. Creating and writing basic rhythmic structures in various permutations

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate application harmonization techniques to pre-existing melodies by:

- 1. Applying block chord harmonization to basic melodies
- 2. Creating simple embellishments of melodies
