



Course Description

RTV1242C | Television Production 2 | 4.00 credits

An intermediate course in television studio production. Students will learn to implement the fundamentals as introduced in Television Production 1 to the production of scripted programs. Prerequisite: RTV1241C

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry-standard television pre-production by:

1. Executing pre-production management and protocol
2. Determining advanced studio lighting and audio schematics
3. Analyzing and developing creative aspects of television production with crew members

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry-standard control room technique by:

1. Defining crew positions and individual responsibilities for a television control room
2. Implementing crew positions and control room protocol
3. Identifying advanced switcher and video effects capabilities
4. Recording a scripted program

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry-standard television production by:

1. Defining crew positions and individual responsibilities for the television studio
2. Implementing crew positions and studio protocol
3. Identifying video camera operation
4. Recording a live television program
