RTV2243C | Directing | 3.00 credits

An introductory overview of television directing. Students will learn the responsibilities of the television director in coordinating production elements and television control room techniques. Prerequisite: RTV1242C

Course Competencies

- 1. Interpreting a script for camera placement and staging
- 2. Interpreting a script for lighting and audio needs
- 3. Reviewing scripts to conform to studio capabilities

- 2. Supervising crew positions in the studio and control room
- 3. Directing a production that meets schedule and budget parameters
