In this intermediate workshop-style class, students will learn about documentary production. Prerequisite: RTV2245C

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will understand the aesthetics of nonfiction projects by:

1. Identifying the components of effective nonfiction storytelling
2. Identifying the role of ethics in nonfiction storytelling
3. Applying aesthetic techniques to service-learning projects and short documentaries
4. Screening and critiquing service-learning projects and short documentaries

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry standard pre-production for nonfiction projects by:

1. Researching organizations and documentary subjects
2. Communicating professionally with organization personnel and documentary subjects
3. Developing treatments and scripts for projects
4. Creating budgets and schedules for projects

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry-standard production for nonfiction projects by:

1. Applying industry standard pre-visualization techniques
2. Implementing shots as determined in preproduction
3. Analyzing and critiquing technical choices in camera, lighting, and sound

1. Developing a workflow for editing projects
2. Utilizing editing techniques to complete projects
3. Integrating audio, color management, and graphic techniques for completing projects
4. Analyzing and critiquing completed projects
