



Course Description

RTV2942 | Spring Television Practicum | 3.00 Credits

This course is an advanced internship with limited enrollment requiring departmental approval. Students will learn advanced camera and lighting techniques while assisting in the production of shows for Cable-TAP television, Miami-Dade County's official community access channel. AS degree credit only. Prerequisite: RTV1242C

Course Competencies:

4. Interviewing for a position on MDC TV
