



Course Description

RTV3277C | Television Studio Production Workshop | 3.00 credits

In this upper division workshop class for BAS students in Film, Television & Digital Production students will learn advanced television studio production techniques for pre-scripted programs. Prerequisite: RTV2246C, FIL2515C.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency in the planning of a television studio production by:

1. Writing properly formatted scripts for live television
2. Developing original program concepts
3. Organizing and preparing a project “pitch”
4. Identifying the resources needed for a television studio production

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate proficiency in advanced television studio pre- production by:

1. Identifying television studio crew
2. Implementing Arranging crew positions to create a television studio production
3. Preparing studio equipment for a television production
4. Creating an itemized budget and schedule
4. Casting actors for required roles

Competency 3: The student will apply for advanced television studio production by:

1. Incorporating advanced techniques in the operation of a television studio
2. Producing a studio a scripted television program
3. Generating all applicable paperwork
4. Following Ensuring proper television studio protocols and procedures
