SON2854 | Clinic 6 | 3.00 credits

This is the last in a series of six (6) clinics in which the student is assigned to a medical facility. The student is afforded hands-on experience in sonography under the supervision of a clinical instructor, sonographer or physician. Prerequisite: SON2844.

Course Competencies
