## STS2360 | Professional Skills for the Surgical Technologist | 2.00 credits

This course will cover professional management, communication skills and teamwork, ethical and moral issues in the healthcare setting, and legal issues and risk management.

## Course Competencies

- 2. Citing examples of tasks that are required for the surgical technologist
- 3. Demonstrating tasks that are scope of practice-specific

- 1. Explaining legal ramifications for HIPPA violation
- 2. Citing examples of HIPPA violation
- 3. Explaining patient rights concerning records and confidential information

- 1. Explaining the significance of the certified surgical technologist credential
- 2. Demonstrating a "time out" for patient safety
- 3. Demonstrating a correct count on an instrument count and documentation
