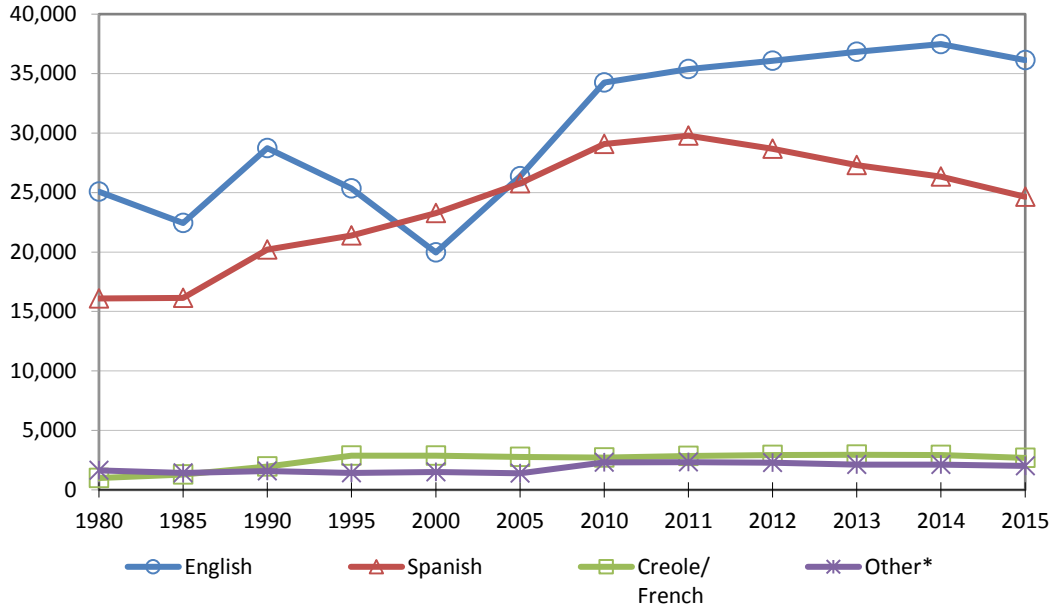


Native Language of Credit Students

- The influx of immigrants into Miami-Dade County is evident from the native languages reported by students.
- MDC students report 77 different native languages in Fall 2015, including English.
 - 55% report a native language of English.
 - 38% report a native language of Spanish.
 - Our Haitian population is reflected by 2,676 students with a native language of Creole or French.
