



Crime Alert Sex Offense: Fondling

On June 21, 2019, at approximately 2:30pm, two female students reported that they had been fondled on two different occasions on Campus by the same Subject. The first female student stated while she was in the cafeteria Building 8000 she was inappropriate fondled between April 15, 2019 and April 20, 2019. The second female student stated that on April 17, 2019 while on the east side of the cafeteria Building 8000, she was inappropriately fondled.

Both victims stated that the subject hovered over them, then ask them for hugs, and without their consents inappropriately fondled them. Miami-Dade Police Department was contact and both incidents are being investigated.

Both victims described the subject:

• 20-25 year old Black male, 5'10" 185 lbs., heavy set build.

Safety Tips:

- Walk with a friend to and from class.
- Don't accept any hugs by unknown individuals.
- Report any inappropriate contact.
- •Report any suspicious activity to the Campus Public Safety, 24 hours a day, at 305-237-2100.
- Students needing assistance navigating the campus at any hour may request a Public Safety Officer to escort them accordingly.
