





WORLD NEWS Jeb Bush gets set to make it official


One of the biggest names expected to enter the race for the Republican nomination for president in 2016 is set to make things official.

Jeb Bush, both the son and brother of former presidents, tweeted out a teaser on Thursday morning, confirming he will make an announcement on June 15, reports Megan Murphy in Washington.

The announcement will be made at Miami Dade College in southern Florida, symbolic of Mr Bush's deep commitment to education reform.

The former Florida governor, one of the best-known candidates in what will be a jam-packed GOP field, is considered one of the early frontrunners and has assembled a formidable fundraising team that has already raised an enviable war chest for his campaign.

However, some Republican donors have expressed concern about his struggle to gain any momentum with rank-and-file voters since he first announced he would explore a presidential run in December.
