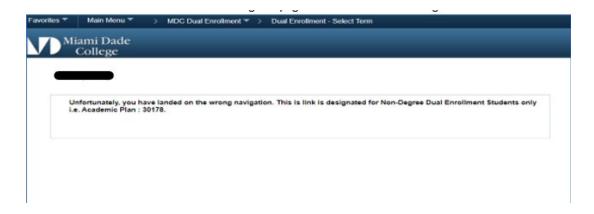
INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEARCHING AND SELECTING COURSES USING THE DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENT PORTAL

STEP 1: USE the following link to log into your MDC Account:

http://destudent.mdc.edu



NOTE: Students that are NOT part of the Dual Enrollment Program will not be able to access the shared portal. In this instance, students will receive the following message:

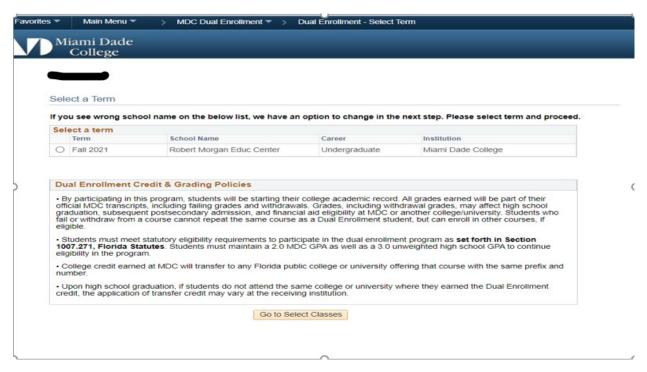

STEP 2: Select Term for Dual Enrollment Registration



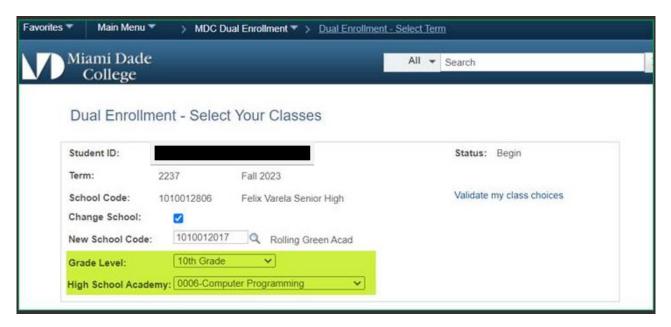
NOTE: Read MDC's dual enrollment credit & grading policies before selecting courses.

Answer: Select the school of record before continuing on to the next step. You will have the option of changing schools when you navigate to the 'Go to Select Classes' page.



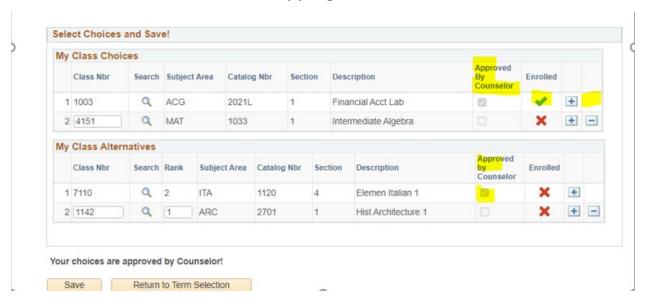
STEP 3: Indicate your grade level and high school academy/career interest.



Note: MDC is interested in learning about your career interests. This helps the College provide a guided career pathway to support your dual enrollment experience. If you are in a high school academy, please select this option. You are also welcome to select a particular career interest.

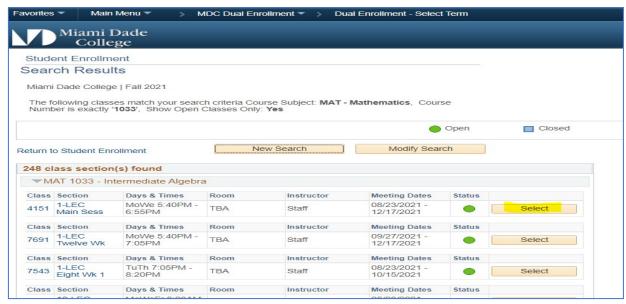
MDC recommends selecting **Collegiate/Advance College Degree** If your goal is to pursue a bachelor's degree.

STEP 4: Add Classes to Your Shopping Cart



On the **Dual Enrollment – Select Your Classes** page, you will be able to:

- 1) Indicate a change of school
- 2) Search and select your new school
- 3) Add your current grade level
- 4) Indicate your current High School Academy or Career Interest
- 5) Search for courses to add to the shopping cart



The search function will let you know whether a class is open or closed. It will provide meeting dates and times. Click on the section to see the instruction modality (in-person, blended, Online, or MDC LIVE).

**IMPORTANT:

1. Don't Forget to Save the Courses to your shopping cart.

- 2. Remember to validate your class choices, as this will help determine whether you are eligible to take the courses that you have selected. The system will screen for any prerequisite or co-requisite courses as well as other determining factors.
- 3. You will see all classes that have been approved by your secondary school counselor. All approved classes will be locked. You will be not be able to change a course once it is approved.
- **4.** A green check indicates that you have been enrolled in a class. A red X means that you have not been enrolled.
- 5. When selecting *My Class Alternatives*, you can select different sections of the same course as well as different courses. If one of your class choices is closed by the time your enrollment request reaches MDC, the Dual Enrollment Coordinator will choose the alternate course that you <u>rank #1</u>. Please rank your alternate courses in terms of preference.
