

# Nursing Program Web Based Course Development Flow Chart



**Instructor**

Instructor is assigned to develop a new Nursing course

Instructor decides to create a Web Assisted Course

## Stage 1 : Web Assisted Course Development

Web Assisted Courses are face to face, instructor taught courses that provide supplemental materials and online content in the Angel LMS. The majority of web enabled courses are web assisted.

Note: (CTD) College Training & Development

Instructor is required to take **CTD 0282** - Overview of Online Teaching.

Content development for a web assisted course can include multi-media development such as a PODCAST for iTunesU.

Nursing Program Instructional Designer assists Instructor in development of content for web assisted course.

Upon completion of **CTD 0282** a web assisted course is made available for development by the Instructor.

Web assisted course is complete or the Instructor can progress to Stage 2.

## Stage 2: Hybrid or Online Course Development

Hybrid courses are used to save classroom space and majority of the course is taught online. An online course is taught completely online.

Note: Instructors are additionally compensated for development of Online courses for the Virtual College.

Instructor decides to teach a hybrid or online course for Virtual College

The Instructor is the content expert and the Virtual College Instructional Designer supervise the development of the course and ensures quality control.

Instructor is required to take **CTD 0280** - Develop a Virtual College Course and **CTD 0283** - Virtual College Certification

Hybrid or Online course is complete.
