POLICY TITLE: Educator Credentialing, Professional Learning, and Misconduct Reporting

1. This policy establishes Miami Dade College's (MDC) framework as a charter school sponsor and local education agency for oversight of educator credentialing, professional learning and reporting of educator misconduct. MDC shall ensure that charter school instructional staff are qualified and employees are held to the highest ethical standards of the profession.
2. The Florida Charter Institute (FCI) is authorized to maintain systems, procedures and verification mechanisms to ensure that personnel employed by sponsored charter schools are properly certified, meet professional learning requirements, and are subject to required misconduct reporting and oversight. FCI activities shall focus on verification, coordination and compliance assurance, and shall not involve management of school-level personnel decisions or actions.
3. Procedures. The Executive Director of the Florida Charter Institute is responsible for and authorized to adopt procedures necessary for implementing this policy.
