1. The purpose of this policy is to establish the standards used by Miami Dade College (MDC) and the Florida Charter Institute (FCI) to oversee its sponsored charter schools. Ongoing oversight for MDC-sponsored charter schools is central to the autonomy and accountability that serves as the foundation for the vision, goals and authorizing priorities of MDC. This ensures consistent expectations, promotes high-quality educational outcomes and protects school autonomy across all sponsored schools.
2. Annual Monitoring Calendar. FCI shall maintain a comprehensive annual monitoring calendar outlining all required reporting deadlines, review windows, and oversight activities for each sponsored school.
3. Site Visits and Records Reviews. FCI shall conduct regular site visits and records reviews to ensure compliance in all domains (e.g., academics, finance, governance, safety) by sponsored charter schools. Enforcement actions will be guided by and proportionate to the severity, frequency, and impact of the identified deficiencies, and shall align with MDC's responsibilities as an authorizer.
4. Annual Report to MDC. The governing board of each charter school shall report its progress annually to MDC, and MDC shall forward the report to the Commissioner of Education at the same time as other annual school accountability reports.
5. Procedures. The Executive Director of the FCI is responsible for and authorized to adopt procedures necessary for implementing this policy.
