I. PURPOSE

To provide for a student who has become a bona fide resident of Florida to initially qualify for in-State Tuition, or to change residency status.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. Students attending College credit programs or courses must be classified for in-State or Out-of-State tuition rates. An affidavit of residency must be completed, with supporting documentation, on initial application to the College and submitted to the Registrar's Office.
- B. Dependent students must have parent or legal guardian complete the affidavit with supporting documentation.
- C. The effective date of the changed residency status will be the next term unless the Registrar believes the student to have been a bona fide resident of Florida on the first day of classes of the current term.
- D. Any prior student not enrolled at the College for more than one year must re-establish residency for tuition status by the methods described above.
