I. PURPOSE

To provide a process of the recording of credits earned by examination on the student's permanent record.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. Standardized Credit-by-Exams (CLEP, DANTES, AP, etc.) are processed using the minimum scores, credits, and guidelines by the State of Florida's Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC).
- B. Institutional credit-by-exams are recorded in the College's record keeping system by the academic department, as illustrated in Technical Manual of Procedure 1100:407201 – Obtaining and Recording Credit Earned by Institutional Credit-By-Exam.
