



# **Foreign Transcripts Checklist**

## **Foreign High School Requirements**

Foreign High School (Country is part of the Hague Convention)	<ul> <li>Official diploma with apostille and a certified English translation from ATAnet.org (required for documents not issued in English). Exceptions may apply.</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Official diploma with an evaluation Report from NACES, AICE or M-DCPS Foreign Adult Document Evaluation Services department. The report must state equivalency to U.S. high school graduation.</li> </ul>
Foreign High School (Country is <u>not</u> part of the Hague Convention)	<ul> <li>Official Diploma and a certified English translation from ATAnet.org (required for documents not issued in English). Exceptions may apply.</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Official diploma with an evaluation Report from NACES, AICE or M-DCPS Foreign Adult Document Evaluation Services department. The report must state equivalency to U.S. high school graduation.</li> </ul>
Foreign High School (Country is part of the Islands or African)	<ul> <li>Official GCSE, CXC, OR West African Examinations with a minimum of 5 Academic Subjects. Only one of the subjects may be an elective.</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Evaluation Report from NACES, AICE or M-DCPS Foreign Adult Document Evaluation Services department. The report must state equivalency to U.S. high school graduation.</li> </ul>

### **Foreign College/University Requirements**

Foreign University	<ul> <li>Official transcript and diploma with a course by course evaluation from a</li></ul>
(Degree Earned)	NACES or AICE member.
Foreign University	<ul> <li>Official Transcripts with apostille and a certified English translation from ATAnet.org (required for</li></ul>
( <u>No</u> Degree Earned)	documents not issued in English). Exceptions may apply.
	Or
	<ul> <li>Official Transcripts with an evaluation report from NACES or AICE.</li> </ul>

- All documents must have <u>at least</u> one matching last name. If last name does not match, a legal document to support the name change will be required
- All documents must be official and original.
- All documents are subject to verification. Students will be contacted should further information is required.
- Miami Dade College reserves the right to request a foreign credential evaluation report from a NACES or AICE member.
- Staff must make copies of all parts of the documents and will only stamp the copies of official documents.
